DEMOCRATS OPEN NEW HEADQUARTERS IN PEORIA

The West Dems organization opened their office on Thursday, November 1 in Peoria. Susan Ransdell, president of the West Dems announced that the office will be open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. to serve voters in Legislative Districts 4, 9, 10 and 12. Between November 1 and January 4, much of the focus of volunteers working in the office will be to register Democrats who wish to be eligible to vote in the Presidential Preference Primary and in encouraging Democrats to request their names be added to the Permanent Early Voting List.

The West Dems will coordinate voter outreach, registration of new voters, distribute candidate information and provide other voter services for the four legislative districts and congressional district 2. Voters will be able to learn about national, statewide and Maricopa County candidates as well as the local district candidates. Phone banking is underway and neighborhood canvasses have been scheduled. Those wishing to assist in the work of the West Democratic office should call (623) 249-7407.

"This is the earliest date for opening a Democratic office in the West Valley," stated Shirley McAllister, chair of LD9. "In previous years we may have been open for three or four months prior to the election. This time we are open a full year prior to Election Day 2008. This facility is definitely needed because of the growth in population in the West Valley."

Located in Columbia Square on the Northeast corner of Cactus and 75th Avenue, the facility is easily accessible from the Loop 101 as well as major cross streets, making it ideal to serve voters from all four districts. Lois Pfau, chair of LD10 believes volunteers from her district will find this location easier to reach than past offices have been.
